Applications are invited from qualified individuals for one position in Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopaedics, to begin January 1, 2025, or as soon as possible thereafter. The successful candidate will be appointed to a Full-time Probationary (tenure-track) faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor, preferred. Exceptional applicants will be considered for an appointment at a higher rank. Qualified applicants will have a DDS/DMD degree (or equivalent), as well as training in an advanced specialty program in Orthodontics granting them an MSc, PhD, or equivalent graduate degree. Candidates must be eligible to obtain a specialty license in Orthodontics with the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario. Fellowship in the Royal College of Dentists of Canada and/or Board Certification with the American Board of Orthodontics is also preferred.
