ACADEMIC POSITION – MALIGNANT HEMATOLOGY – LYMPHOMA/MYELOMA

The Department of Medicine, Division of Hematology Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, at Western University and London Health Sciences Centre and St. Joseph's Health Care Centre are seeking a Hematologist with at least one (1)-year experience in Malignant Hematology with a focus in lymphoproliferative disorders/multiple myeloma for a full-time academic appointment to Western University. The candidate will fill a clinical academic role as a Clinician Researcher or a Clinician Teacher.

The Division of Hematology currently has 16 members and is well-recognized and respected both nationally and internationally. The Division's physicians provide the whole range of hematologic services including all malignant hematology (leukemia, lymphoma, and myeloma), stem cell transplantation, thrombosis and hemophilia services as well as laboratory service in Southwestern Ontario and beyond. The Division has a fully certified Royal College Subspecialty Training Program in the Department of Medicine.

The successful candidate is expected to have completed training in Hematology and is expected to have a strong interest and a proven track record in clinical research or education related to Hematology with a focus in lymphoproliferative disorders and related conditions. Additional training in the management of patients with lymphoproliferative disorders / multiple myeloma is highly desirable. Applicants should be certified, or eligible for certification, in Hematology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent. Candidates must have an MD, or equivalent, and must be eligible for licensure by the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) in the province of Ontario. The successful candidate will hold a limited term academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor, or a continuing academic appointment at the
