In accordance with the regulations set for Tier I CRCs (www.chairschaires.gc.ca), the successful candidate will be an outstanding and innovative researcher whose accomplishments have made a major impact and be recognized internationally as a leader in their field and have a superior record of attracting and supervising graduate standards and encouraged to apply.

A successful candidate holding a PhD in a relevant field will be appointed in a probationary (tenure-track) position at the rank of Associate Professor or a tenured position at the rank of Associate Professor or Full Professor depending on the qualifications and experience. Compensation for this position will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The candidate will be appointed in the Department of Physiology and Pharmacology in the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry with a potential joint appointment in appropriate departments within the Schulich School of Medicine9(f)-2s may have impacted them.
