CALENDAR DESCRIPTION

Reading and discussion on selected topics in Kinesiology agreed upon through consultation between the student and the supervising professor. All fourth year honors Kinesiology students and, in some cases third year students, are eligible to enroll subject to Faculty procedural guidelines and approval.

If you have not taken a course, lack of a pre-requisite or the completion of an anti-requisite cannot be used as a basis for appeal. If you are found ineligible for a course, you may be removed from it at any time and you will receive no adjustment to your fees. This decision cannot be appealed.

Independent Study Project The nature of the project and its specifications are organized and agreed to, between the student and his or her faculty mentor. The project in its entirety is to be submitted no later than
