Most practice partners have onboarding requirements that students must complete for that specific agency in preparation for a placement. Some agencies accept verification of completion from the School of Nursing, while others require students to submit documentation directly to the agencies. This is the student's responsibility, if requested, as the School of Nursing does not have access to students' requirement documents and the School's clearance partner (Synergy Verified) cannot release documents to third parties. Students are responsible for any costs associated with agency onboarding requirements, and these are separate from the School's pre-placement fees and processes.

: The use of clinical experiential learning in the context of this policy includes all program activities related to experiential learning, including but not limited to laboratory practice, clinical placements and experiential learning in research, practice and leadership.
