## **Participation active (10%)**

Attendance is mandatory. The success of your learning experience in any course requires that you regularly attend classes. This is particularly true of language courses. On average, students are expected to spend at least 3 hours a week reviewing the material covered in class and preparing for the next class.

Two assessments will be conducted in class for a duration of 110 minutes each. No aids are allowed. If you are absent for a valid reason, you must provide adequate written justification for your absence (see document modations for work missed due to problems below) in order to be granted a make-up test.

The final exam assesses your knowledge of the material covered in class. Information about the structure of the exam will be provided in the last week of classes. The final exam is 3 hours long. No aids are allowed.
