Hand sanitizers, masks and test kits continue to be available on campus.

Geese management.

- Initiatives have been started in educating the community on geese, their nesting habits, their consequences on traffic.
- An online geese reporting tool has been created by FM to allow for reporting on geese issues.

As of the end of February 2023, 61 incidents have been reported on campus: 42

First Aid related incidents, 10 Lost Time related incidents and 9 Health Care related incidents.

- Of these 61 incidents, falls were 9 (15%) and other incidents were 52 (85%).

- A worker sustained a critical injury after slipping on ice near the Health Sciences Building.
- The accident location was inspected by the Ministry of Labor, and actions have been taken to prevent further accidents.
