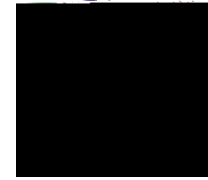

SEQUENCE OF TASK

Assess and prepare equipment and chemical mixture

POTENTIAL HAZARDS

- a) Back injury
- b) Overexertion strain
- c) Slip, trip, fall

ACTION OR PROCEDURE

- a) Assess and inspect equipment such as pail or bucket, use funnels as required.
- b) Do not exceed weight restrictions when lifting products.
- c) Staff to watch proper footing and pedestrian traffic around them, while using caution to work environment awareness. Leave wet floor signs in position where spillage occurs, use barriers and signage and, if possible, close area until floor is cleaned and dry. Clean spills immediately if possible.
