Awarded to graduate students in the Master of Data Analytics program, Faculty of Science based on academic achievement and their career interest in data analytics. Candidates must be Canadian citizens or eligible to work in Canada. Recipients will have an opportunity to interview for a work term or internship with WSB. Students are not guaranteed a work term or internship with WSB. An offer of full-time employment with WSB may also be extended pending successful completion of the program and

employment with WSB following graduation to receive or retain the award.

Students must complete an application form in accordance with the deadline announced annually by the Faculty of Science. A limited number of applicants will be chosen to participate in an interview.

A selection committee made up of representatives from the Faculty of Science will short list applicants for the award. Short-listed candidates will be interviewed by a representative from WSIB, a member of Science Graduate Studies and the Director of the MDA program or designate. Final selection of recipients will be made by the Faculty of Science. At least one representative of the committee must hold membership in the School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies.
