Evaluation

Undergraduate students will be evaluated on the basis of the case, the assignment, the two midterm tests and the nal exam. The nal mark will be based on weights of 5% for each of the case and the assignment, 20% for each of the midterm tests, and 50% for the nal exam.

Graduate students will be evaluated on the basis of the case, two assignments, the two midterm tests and the nal exam. The nal mark will be based on weights of 5% for the case and 2.5% for each of the assignments, 20% for each of the midterm tests, and 50% for the nal exam.

In order to obtain full credit or maximize partial credit on questions, students must outline clearly their approach, showing calculations when necessary.
