

Memorandum of Agreement between The University of Western Ontario's  
Faculty of Health Sciences and Brescia University College Regarding  
Eligibility for Modules in Health Sciences (BHSc) and Kinesiology

Effective September 1, 2004, in conjunction with the introduction of New Academic Choices, Senate approved the Memorandum of Agreement between The University of Western Ontario's Faculty of Health Sciences and Brescia University College, pertaining to the conditions for admission and registration of a limited number of Brescia University College students into undergraduate modules offered in the Bachelor of Health Sciences program and the School of Kinesiology.

Bachelor of Health Sciences Program

Access to the Bachelor of Health Science major module for both internal and external senior transfer students from Brescia (i.e., those who wished to transfer in years 2, 3 or 4 – degree only) will be assessed by the Bachelor of Health Sciences Program due to the limited enrolment nature of the program.

BHSc students (and other Health Science students i.e., Nursing and Kinesiology) will continue to have access to courses in the area of Foods and Nutrition.

Academic counselors at both sites will build good communication links so that implementation of this agreement can run smoothly.

Brescia's website will be updated regularly so that information about the BHSc program is current and accurate.
